

In January 2011, President Obama signed into law the Reduction of Lead in Drinking Water Act, which will reduce the allowable lead content of wetted surfaces in drinking water pipes, pipe fittings and plumbing fixtures. This will take effect on January 4, 2014.

Due to the implementation of this new law, all return requests for leaded brass will be handled on a case by case basis. Some requests may be denied if it is determined that the product cannot be resold prior to the January 4, 2014 deadline.
